ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Quebec high school diploma (DES) or equivalent and have successfully completed the advanced physics course or equivalent.
- Be at least 17 years of age for Canadian students and at least 18 years of age for international students.
- Have an operational language level, as defined by the ICAO (French and English).
- Pass the selection process.
- Pay admission fees (\$400).
- Obtain a category 1 medical certificate issued by Transport Canada before the start of the Session (prerequisite for starting the course, not for admission).

- Have an operational language level, as defined by the ICAO (French and English).
- Pass the selection process.
- Pay admission fees (\$400).
- Obtain a category 1 medical certificate issued by Transport Canada before the start of the Session (prerequisite for starting the course, not for admission).
